## Approach for management

### **Cooperation NODC <=> other national partners:**

- NODC chooses (if needed) a provided method of maintenance: XML files via MIKADO or other tool, or via CMS
- Role NODC: => National focal point
  - Providing assistance in metadata preparation
  - Collating new records
  - Quality control of new metadata descriptions
  - Distributing to portal in case of XML files
  - Contact with central directory managers
- Role Institutes: => Support activities
  - Providing new entries
  - Update existing information.



## 1. Updating EDMERP directory - Projects






### **Management of EDMERP**

### Option 1:

- Editing via CMS forms
- Access for NODC's with national master account
- NODC may create sub-accounts for other institutes in their country (EDMO)
- New records to be created directly in CMS by NODC
- Sub-accounts can also edit/create new, but this will have to be checked by NODC before activating








### Management of EDMERP

### Option 2:


- Via creating and supplying XML V1 files via NODC to central directory.
- The NODC holds the "mother collection" of files, a copy of the central set.

=> 2 options, but only one of the options per country!









Or use Mikado.. But always first contact MARIS when switching.




## Current totals EDMERP

  - When needed for CDI files creation, please also create relevant project




## Searching EDMERP Projects






## Result list EDMERP project






## Details EDMERP project (top)





## Details EDMERP Project (bottom)






## 2. Updating EDMO directory - Organisations





### Management of EDMO

- Updating via CMS forms:
   http://seadatanet.maris2.nl/vu\_organisations/welcome.asp
- Access only for NODC's
- New records only to be created via request from NODC to MARIS (governance is strict, because EDMO is vocabulary)
- When national institute misses organisation in EDMO during work (CDI, EMERP or other) => request to NODC
- Total list: Available as webservice (export only) for use in local systems and Mikado












## Current totals EDMO

- Nov 2011: 2094 from partner countries
- Sept 2012: 2261 from partner countries (Total around 2700 institutes incl. International organisations)
- Activity slow but steady.
