Marine-id

A new flexible way of registering users of marine data

- How transition from previous user directory is managed
- Perspectives

Marine-ID

- Based on user self services for:
 - Quick Initial registration (free logins and passwords)
 - Update profile and password anytime
 - Forgotten password management
- Generic user information so that it can be re-used by different projects or systems:
 - SeaDataNet (on-going)
 - EMODNET (on-going)
 - Others: CORIOLIS, GOSUD (beta testers, done)
- Up and running since May 2014, before SDN users are in there 70 users registered

Components at stake


- A new registration function (PWM open-source software)
- Generic Marine-id user directory (LDAP as usual)
- SDN users profiles database (especially roles)
- Authentication system (still CAS)
- Authorization system (same as now)





























Registration scenario steps

1. Personal Information






Registration scenario steps

2. Confirm email






Registration scenario steps

Transition

- During transition: marine-id auth. service is redirected on historic service.
- Distributed download managers are migrating (new authentication service configuration)
- Final migration step scheduled end of 2014:
 - Registration is switched on Marine-ID. Previously registered users are migrated.
 - Authentication URL is switched to Marine-ID
 - SDN **Authorization** is upgraded to a Marine-ID compliant

Perspectives

- Customer Relationship Management: Better knowledge and support of the marine data users community: on-going experience
- Open SeaDataNet services to communities with their own logins (e.g. google through openid, GIANT through Shibboleth): implemented in 2015
- Offer more data services to marine-id registered users (e.g. MyOcean): still pushing, difficulties because of user management policies
