

Dear colleagues,

Here are the graphs for monitoring the SeaDataNet catalogues content (all documents are available on the extranet of the project under [SeaDataNet II > Follow up](#)).

You can see that there are **increases** on all catalogues **except EDIOS**: EDMO (+8), EDMED (+48), EDMERP (+1), CSR (+243) and CDI (+11 138) (see Figure 1).

For March 2013, the increase in the CDI catalogue is the following (see also Figure 2):

8726 new CDI records have also been input in the CDI catalogue by Geo-Seas partners, which leads to a total increase of **11 138 records** in CDI.

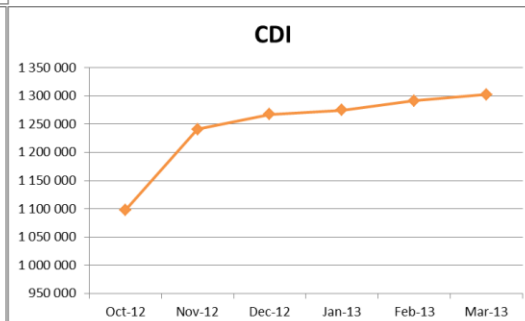
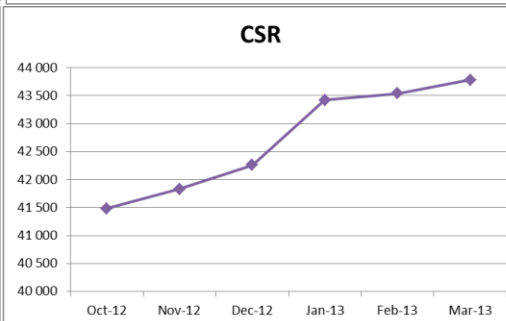
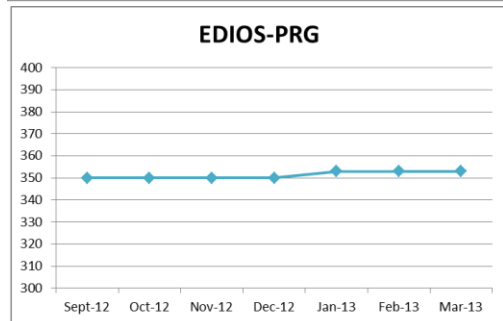
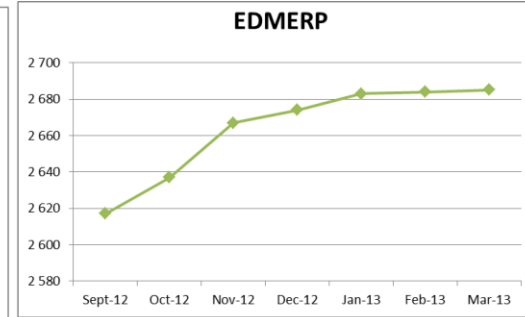
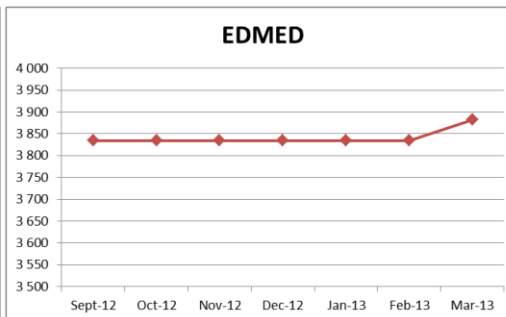
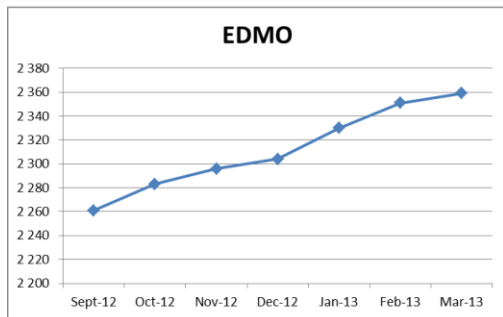




Figure 3 - Nb of CDIs per partner (logarithmic scale), new connections in March 2013

Since the beginning of the monthly follow-up of the catalogues, 6 months ago, it can be underlined that only **17 data providers have input data** in the CDI (green boxes on Figure 3), while **25 others have not added new CDIs** since October 2012 (orange boxes on Figure 3).

**3 new data centres are connected**: INSTM (Tunisia), RSHU (Russian federation) and IOPAN (Poland) (see Figure 3).

5 data providers are still not connected.
