Access to SDN data

- Access to the data is actually managed by a combination of
 - Roles of the connected users (vocab C86)
 - Public, Administrator, Academic, Commercial, Partner...
 - Access restriction policies (Vocab L08)
 - Academic? Commercial, Moratorium, No access, Unrestricted, SeaDataNet licence....
- With a complicated algorithm which actually results
 - Giving **direct access** to every role for **Unrestricted and SeaDataNet licence data**
 - Giving **by negotiation** access to every role **for all other access restrictions**

Simplifications

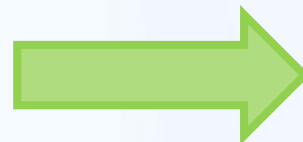
- All SeaDataNet users will have the “Public Role”
- For the access rights

FE - Commercial charge
LI - Licence
MO - Moratorium
NA - No access
OG - Organisation
RS - By negotiation
SR - Academic

- For new MarineID users
 - They will receive a MarineID login/password
 - They will be assigned a Public Role
 - They will agree for the SeaDataNet Licence each time they will download data
- For data centres
 - They will not any more affect roles to their national users
